"Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

(1Thessalonians 5: 16-18, NIV)

I am totally understanding with all the family situations and make no judgments, but I would appreciate (by email, if possible) knowing choir member plans for attendance regarding those two services, as well as *the cantata*, before the time comes upon us - changes may be necessary. Your voice is important to others in the choir that depend on vocal support. When your voice is missing that loss creates a more challenging teaching atmosphere for new music material. 
